Please note that your request, which seeks disclosure of the following, has been processed under the terms of the Freedom of Information Law and our data confirms the following relative to the importation and/or possession of guns:

1. Total Number of Conviction related to importation and/or possession of guns from 2019-2024.

The data reveals the total number of conviction related to importation and/or possession of guns from 2019-2024 is 240.
